

# District 15-6A Varsity Swimming Championships

## Hosted by Magnolia ISD

**Saturday, January 24, 2026 (Varsity Swimming – Timed Finals)**

- Welcome:** Magnolia I.S.D. is proud to host the District 15-6A Varsity Swimming Championships. We wish all competitors the best of luck, and hope that each will achieve their goals!
- Location:** Michael D. Holland Natatorium (Magnolia High School Campus), 14350 FM 1488, Magnolia, TX 77354.
- The pool is located on the Magnolia High School Campus (On the East Side of the High School). The high school is located on the North side of FM 1488 just east of Hwy 149.  
**See maps attached at end of this document.**
- Parking:** **For All Spectators:** Will be located across the street from the natatorium in the high school parking lot. Please follow signs for meet parking. No parking in bus lot (just past natatorium on left) or in lot directly in front of natatorium.
- For Buses:** In bus lot (just past the natatorium on the left). **ONLY BUSES may park in this lot.**
- Conduct:** All persons attending this meet will respect the facilities and follow the verbal and/or written directions/rules of all Magnolia I.S.D. personnel. Any damage to the facility (when proven) will cause the offending team to be held accountable and liable for repairs. It may also result in expulsion from meet.
- No standing in the spectator stands walkways or by the fence for any reason. Violators will be asked to leave the premises if they persist.
- Liability:** The University Interscholastic League, Magnolia Independent School District, and the Michael D. Holland Aquatic Center accepts no responsibility, nor liability, for injuries sustained by any individual, athlete, official, meet volunteer, or spectator while traveling to and from or while participating in the meet.
- Spectators:** Tickets will be available through Hometown link/QR code. A link will be sent out prior to the meet and a QR code will be used at the gate.  
\$4.00-Adults, \$2.00 Students/Children, 65 & Over- Free
- Heat Sheets:** \$3.00 on day of the meet.
- Pool:** The pool consists of eight 9' lanes for competition and 5 lanes for continuous warm up and warm down on the other side of the bulkhead. The starting end of the pool is 13' deep and the turning end is 5'. The pool has a Gen7 Colorado Timing System and full matrix, full color, LED Colorado Timing Scoreboard.

- Seating:** **Spectators:** There is grandstand seating for approx. 200 spectators. We have a maximum fire code building capacity of 1085. Seating will be available on a first-come first-serve basis.
- Athletes:** There will be assigned athlete seating for each school ***based on the number of athletes teams have in the meet.*** Please do not allow your swimmers to sit in the spectator area. Seating assignments for athletes will be sent with warm up information no later than Monday, January 19<sup>th</sup>.

\*ONE WAY ONLY Sprints from Blocks in Lanes 2,3,6,7.

Lanes 4-5 will be OPEN SWIM.

Lanes 1, 8 will be for pace IF a coach is present.

\*The pool will be cleared at **9:45 AM**

\*\*COACHES' MEETING at **9:45 AM** in the Hospitality Room.

\*The Warm Up/Cool Down pool will be open during the entire meet.

**Entry Limit:** Teams are limited to entering a maximum of **4 participants** in each individual event and **1 relay team** per relay event. National H.S. Federation & UIL rules apply to entry requirements. (2 individual events and 2 relays OR 1 individual and 3 relays)

**Deadline:** **Each head coach will be required to submit entries by email to [lsanthin@magnoliaisd.org](mailto:lsanthin@magnoliaisd.org) by 12:00pm on Friday, January 16, 2026, in accordance with UIL rules.**

**Items to be submitted:**

1. Meet entry file for Varsity District Swimming & Diving using Hy-Tek Team Manager software or other software compatible with Hy-Tek.
2. PDF of entries with proof of times for Varsity Districts, which will serve as the official entry form in the event of questions regarding entries.
3. UIL Eligibility Forms.

**YOUR MEET FILE MUST INCLUDE**, the following:

1. The correct Hy-Tek codes for your teams (found here):

2. The correct name associated with the codes.
3. Use numbers (09, 10, 11, 12) **NOT** (FR, SO, JR, SR) for grade description
4. **This meet will be USA Swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. USA-S ID numbers must be correctly entered in the Hy-Tek entry file.**

Once entries close at 12:00 pm Friday, Jan 16th, files will be imported in to Meet Manager software by Meet host. Coaches will receive confirmation report of totals entered in the meet and be notified immediately if any errors found in file (ie. Entering swimmers in too many events). Once notified of any errors you will have until 4:00 pm Friday, the 16th to resolve any errors with host. After this time, host will seed the meet and send out heat sheet to all coaches and post in shared zip folder on google drive.

**Relay Events:** Once a swimmer swims on a relay it will count as one of their events allowed in the meet. National H.S. Federation & U.I.L. rules apply to entry requirements. Relay swimmers must be declared according to the schedule below. List up to eight (8) names for all relays entered. Changes to relay swimmers must be from those eight (8) swimmers listed.

**Relay Card Deadlines:** Relay cards are due to the meet operations booth(elevated section by lane 1) by the following deadlines:

- 200-yard Medley Relay cards – no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the meet.
- 200-yard Free Relay cards – no later than the start of the boys 500-yard freestyle.
- 400-yard Free Relay cards – no later than the start of the girls 100-yard breaststroke.

**Once relay cards have been submitted to the meet operations table, no changes will be permitted according to NFHS Rule 3-2-5 (except as permitted in Rule 3-2-3 for injury or illness).**

**Scoring:** Individual Events: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relays: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

**Awards:** **Medals 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>** Individual & Relay / **Ribbons 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>** Individual & Relay

Team plaques will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place boy & girl teams.

The **TISCA District Competitor of the Meet** will be determined by the **NISCA Power Point rating system** in the Hy-Tek program. In the event of a tie, District head coaches will vote. 1 Girl and 1 Boy will receive this award. The **TISCA District Coach of the Year** is determined by a vote of the Head Coaches only, NO Assistant Coaches vote. \*Coaches must be a member of TISCA to vote.

**Advancers:** The top 6 finishers in each event will advance to the regional meet. Coaches wishing to scratch athletes from individual events to help their relays should do so at the **conclusion of the district meet.**

**Awards:** In an effort to allow the meet to flow and maintain a regular order without too much standing around time, awards will be given at the following designated times.

The Top 3 swimmers will be recognized. The staging area for awards will be on far side of pool by MISD maroon wall. Medalists are encouraged to dress in warmups or in some type of team apparel when on the awards stand. The coach of the winning swimmer or relay in that event will hand out awards for that event.

***Diving will be awarded on January 22<sup>nd</sup> for the diving events and will be announced again on Saturday, January 24<sup>th</sup> during the Swimming events.***

**Timing Lane Assignments by team will be sent with other meet info by Monday, Jan 19<sup>th</sup>.**

**Concession:** Concessions & hospitality will be available throughout the meet. Hospitality is available ONLY for those persons working at the meet (timers, officials, coaches, meet management personnel). NO ATHLETES ALLOWED in the Hospitality room!

**T-Shirt Sales:** Fine Designs will be on-site selling custom t-shirts and other apparel.

**Video/Filming:** Filming or videotaping will be permitted in the spectator area as long as it doesn't obstruct the view of other spectators. Videotape or film will NOT be used in judging any swimming event. Please be sensitive to the other spectators. No standing in front of the spectator area for any reason. Violators will be asked to leave the premises if they persist

**Restrooms:** Athletes are to use the athlete specified locker rooms in the pool area. There is a separate set of bathrooms in the lobby for all other adults or children attending the meet.

**Rules, Regulation, Prohibitions, and Deck Access:**

- **Any abusive or offensive language and/or conduct WILL NOT be tolerated in any capacity and will result in the immediate removal from Magnolia I.S.D. property.**
- All persons attending the meet must follow the written and/or verbal directions of the Meet Referee, Meet Director(s), and all Magnolia I.S.D. personnel.
- All participants must follow the CDC "*Healthy swimming policy*" and shower before warm-up.
- Shaving is not permitted anywhere within the entire MISD Natatorium Complex.
- Deck changing is strictly prohibited and subject to disqualification from the meet.
- Security personnel are empowered to enforce any and all regulations established by MISD.
- Only participants, coaches, event administrators, and event volunteers are allowed on the pool deck – all spectators and parents must remain in the grandstand.
- Participants in swim suits are not allowed in the spectator seating area. Participants and spectators are not allowed to lean against the rails, stand in front of or in any of the bleachers, or pass any posted barriers.
- Lawn Chairs are not allowed in the MISD Natatorium Grandstand-seating area, Stadium seats shall not exceed 17" wide x 13" deep.
- Each competing team is permitted one temporary banner, placed at the discretion of the MISD Natatorium Director. Team banners must not exceed 5' by 8'.
- Absolutely no tobacco, electronic cigarettes (vape-pen/E-Cig), alcohol products, or glass containers are allowed on Magnolia School District property. This applies to the parking lot.
- Teams are allowed an Ice-Chest (1) PER GENDER on the deck **provided they do not contain glass items**, bottled water is allowed.
- Teams are expected to police their respective areas at the conclusion of the competition.
- Participating in any activity that can be interpreted or described as "*risky*" or "*horseplay*" is prohibited throughout the entire MISD Natatorium Complex.
- Diving equipment such as trampoline and spotting rigs are not to be used unless authorized by the MISD Natatorium Director.
- The use of flash cameras or noise-makers at the start, during or end of any race is prohibited.
- Blocking or restricting fire lanes or emergency exits, and the use of emergency exits for non-emergency use is prohibited.

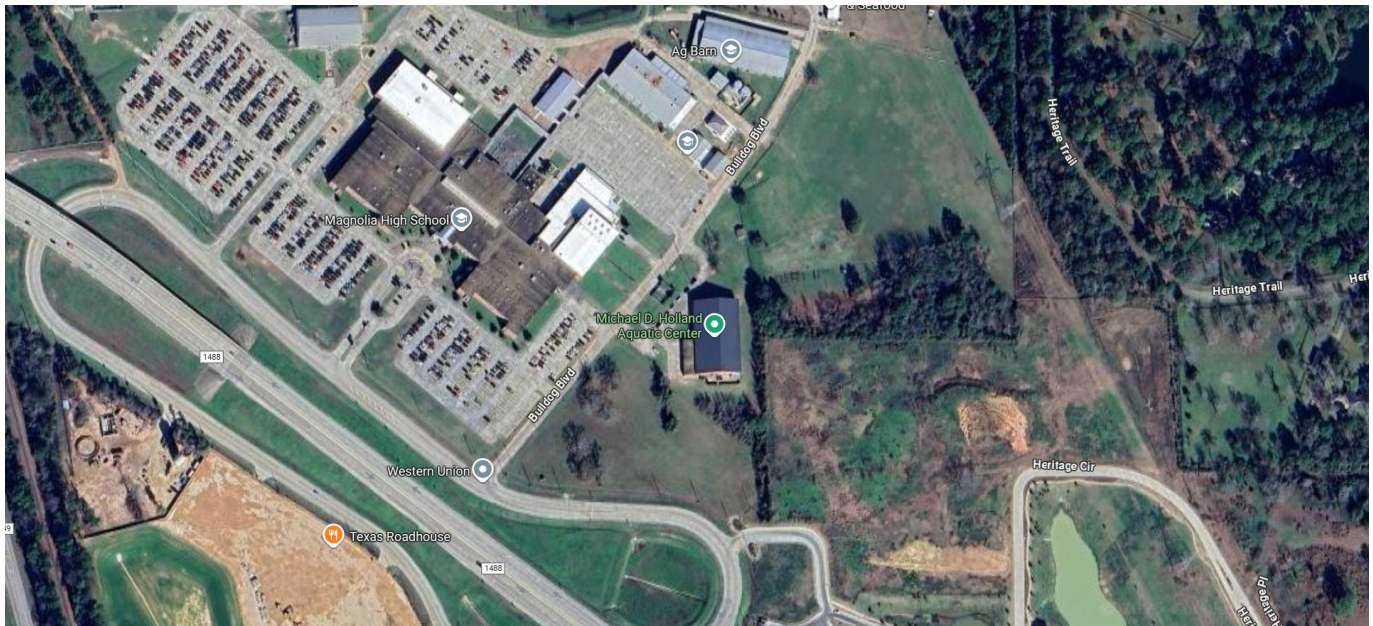
**Access to the deck of the MISD Natatorium is restricted to the following:**

● Athletes from competing teams ● Administrative support personnel ● Coaches of competing teams ● Facility/District Staff ● Officials ● Marshals ● Timing System operators ● Security personnel ● Computer systems operators ● Lifeguards ● Lane timers ● Service and supply vendors ● Credentialed media personnel ● Hospitality personnel ● One photographer from each competing team ● Medical support personnel ● Other personnel on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Meet Director(s) or the Meet Referee.

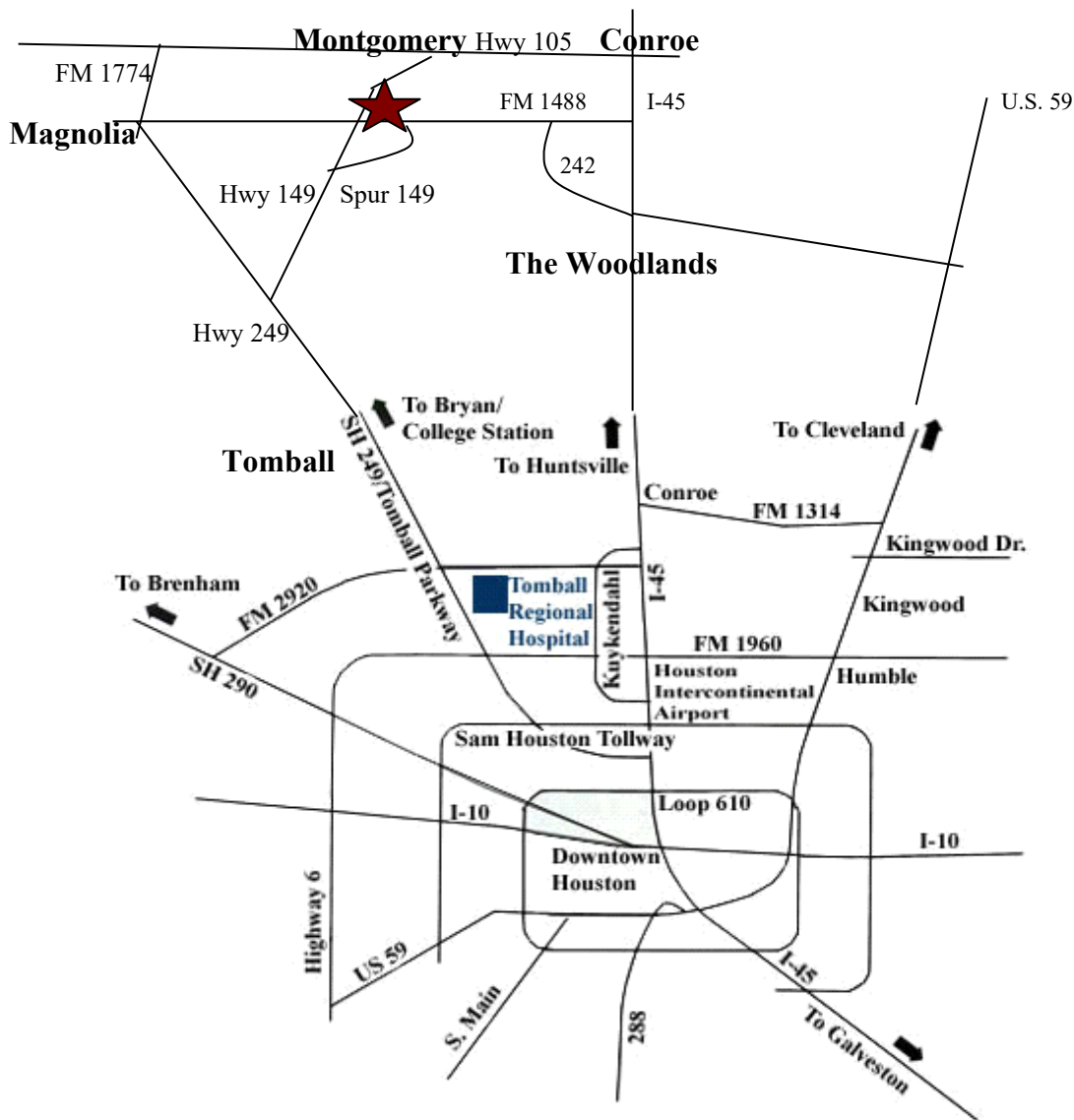
