

Entry Limit: Only athletes who did not swim at the Varsity District Championship may be entered. All National Federation & UIL rules apply to entry requirements. (2 individual events and 2 relays OR 1 individual event and 3 relays) Teams are limited to entering a maximum of 4 participants in each individual event and **2 relay team per relay event.** The exception is the 50 & 100 freestyle events are unlimited entries however, only 4 swimmers can score from each team. A-relays can only score. All competitors listed in the HY file are eligible for relays.

Deadline: Each head coach will be required to submit entries in a Google Drive folder by 12:00pm on Friday, January 16, 2026, in accordance with UIL rules. The Host Site will set up the Google Drive folder and send out the link by January 1st of the year the meet is being held.

To be submitted

1. Meet entry file for JV District
2. PDF of entries with proof of times for JV District
3. Dive Sheet for JV District

Divers must be declared on the entry form. Dive sheets must be finalized 1 hour prior to the start of the diving competition on January 22nd. Meet officials will check all Diving Sheets and any incorrect Diving Sheets will be **disqualified** from the competition.
